ITINERARY

DAY
1

Individual arrival to Copenhagen

The Danish capital has a lot to offer, an early arrival is highly recommended. Take a stroll through the medieval city center or visit the famous Tivoli. In the evening you will receive your rental bikes as well as a personal welcome briefing.

DAY
2

Copenhagen - Vedbæk / surroundings | ca. 25 km

You leave Copenhagen up north. Today's route leads you along the Öresund, the strait between Zealand in Denmark and Skåne, also known as Scania, in Sweden. Accompanied by the Baltic Sea you will soon arrive at the well-known beach Bellevue. A quick dip in the cool water is the perfect refreshment. It is also worth taking a short detour to Dyrehavsbakken, the oldest existing amusement park in the world.

DAY
3

Vedbæk / surroundings - Helsingborg | ca. 30 km

Today you ride again along the coastline with magnificent views of the Baltic Sea. On the way we recommend to stop at the Louisiana Museum, it is the most significant museum for modern and contemporary art in Denmark. In Helsingør, it is worth visiting the Kronborg castle. Finally, after a short ferry ride, you will arrive at Helsingborg. Welcome to Sweden!

DAY
4

Helsingborg - Landskrona | ca. 30 km

Helsingborg has a lot to offer! The wide range of cultural activities and the picturesque old quarter will delight you. Your route leads you along the Swedish coast today. Along the way, you pass many small and idyllic fishing villages. From Landskrona you can do a short excursion to the Ven island in Öresund. The entire island is a nature reserve and offers unique scenery which is explored ideally by bike.

DAY
5**Landskrona - Lund** | ca. 40 km


In Landskrona you should definitely visit the citadel in the city center. This town is however not only for art and culture enthusiasts, the magnificent beaches promise cooling refreshment. Back on the bike, you are going to follow the coast for most of the way. You peddle through a few gorgeous nature reserves. The final part brings you inland, before you reach today's goal, one of Sweden's oldest cities and university town Lund.

DAY
6**Lund - Malmö** | ca. 25 km

Back at the coast, the flat beaches of Lomma are perfect for a swim in the Sea. Just a little further along, you will reach the final goal of your trip, Malmö. It is Sweden's third-largest city and offers many attractions. The picturesque old quarter and the Malmöhus castle should not be missed.

7**Individual departure or extra nights**
